



# ARKANSAS RIVER WATERSHED COLLABORATIVE



- ▶ **LAWQ: Implement at least three on-farm soil health/improved irrigation demonstration projects across the basin below Pueblo Reservoir.**
- ▶ **Participate in/host at least two watershed-health outreach events and present about ARWC and its projects at three conferences/meetings; .**
- ▶ **Assist at least five municipal utilities/conservancy districts to prioritize and input their infrastructure into the federal Wildfire Decision Support System**
- ▶ **Treat at least 200 acres of prioritized forest to mitigate wildfire impacts to critical water infrastructure.**
- ▶ **Continue working to reduce the impacts of 2016 wildfires, by implementing at least \$50,000 worth of post-fire recovery projects that are not funded by CWCB.**
- ▶ **Create at least two Stream Management Plans.**
- ▶ **Incorporate ARWC as a 501(c)3 nonprofit and continue to build governance and capacity for both ARWC and sub-basin collaboratives.**
- ▶ **Manage the grant for success.**
